& Predoctoral Research Fellowship 2023-2024

The Crossing Latinidades Humanities Research Initiative seeks applicants for its Summer Institute in Latino Humanities Studies Methodologies and Theories. Eligible applicants **must** have completed their **second** or **third year** in humanities and humanistic social science PhD programs, and not yet be ABD by May 2023. The Summer Institute is an intense in-person pre-doctoral program held at the University of Illinois at Chicago campus. Each participant receives a \$3,000 stipend to cover all travel, a few meals not offered by the institute, and other minor expenses incurred while attending. Housing is provided on the UIC campus. Selected participants will be enrolled in the two-semester **Crossing Latinidades Mentorship Program** with a faculty mentor outside their university and will also be expected to attend virtual Professionalization Workshops during the fall of 2023 and spring of 2024.

With this application, you may also be considered for an **11-month Crossing Latinidades Predoctoral Research Fellowship** which carries a stipend of \$30,000, and a tuition waiver and health insurance at your university. To be eligible, you must forego any other employment, such as TAships and GRAships, and commit to participate in the Crossing Latinidades Research Working Groups for 20 hours per week.
